


- Less likely to persist in STEM majors

## WAYS YOU CAN INCREASE ALLY BEHAVIORS


- Listen (WAIT = Why Am I Talking)


# WAYS YOU CAN INCREASE ALLY BEHAVIORS

- Become aware of your biases
